Like you, I was tremendously disappointed in Governor Tom Wolf's intimidating "recommendation" to cancel all recreational and interscholastic athletics until January of 2021. I am writing to remind you that this is not a mandate, and I am asking you to stand firm on your previous decision to continue with PIAA-sanctioned events during the fall athletic season.
